## Did you know?

When foals are born, their legs are already 80-90% of the length they will be once fully grown.

Since horse's eyes are positioned on the sides of their head, they can see nearly 360 degrees around them (minus small blind spots directly in front and behind of them).

They can sleep both lying down and standing up!
